- ID Travel entitlement on SK after one month of employment

- Cohabitant registration after one month of cohabitation

- 20 Travel Partner tickets annually on SK flights, 12 on Star Airlines  
IN EFFECT 01JAN2019
- Economy Plus as default class when downgrading from Business Class  
IN EFFECT 01FEB2019
- Children 8-11 allowed in Business Class (trial period)  
IN EFFECT 01JAN2019
- No age limit for children of active employees  
IN EFFECT 01JAN2019
- R1 tickets available for Business Class  
IN EFFECT 01MAY2018
- SAS Staff Discount/Guaranteed Seats only available for active employees  
IN EFFECT 01JAN2019
- Family members registered for ID Travel may bring travel companions on SAS Staff Discount/Guaranteed Seats tickets  
IN EFFECT 01JAN2019
- Tickets as retiree for same number of years as in active employment  
IN EFFECT 01JAN2019 for employees entering agreement for retirement after 31. December 2018
- New Planning Tool in myIDTravel. Provides overview of availability, status and priority

- New tool for self-registration of family members in myIDTravel

- Parents removed as category for ID Travel

- Login to myIDTravel via the internet using your employee number instead of your ITA number (log in via SAS intranet will stay the same). Retirees shall continue to use ITA number as their ID for login.
