Paid Warm-Up	Purpose : To provide horses and riders 4 minutes in the competition arena for familiarization.
Cross Enter	 Within NSBA, and AQHA, a horse cannot "cross enter" in certain classes, regardless of the association. Trail and Ranch Trail Ranch riding and Western Pleasure Ranch Rail and Western Pleasure Rules of cross enter does not apply to Allbreed classes.
Allbreed Classes in general	Participation: No membership required.Rules: Judged according to AQHA rules.Bits: The classes goes under Level-1 rule, witch means you can ride a snaffle regardless of the horses age.
Allbreed Open	Open for all horses and riders/handlers
Allbreed Non Pro	Open to amateur/youth riders according to AQHA's rulebook. Amateurs and youth compete together.





	Rules
	Amateur riders are not allowed to earn money by training other riders or other people's horses. Simply put - you ride your own (or leased) horse for fun!Youth, A rider younger than 19 years old, you can show in youth classes throughout the year you turn 19.
Allbreed Novice Nonpro	Riders who would be eligible for AQHA Level 1 are eligible for Allbreed Novice classes. Riders who are eligible for WRAN/WRAS D&C level and lower levels. A class with a slightly simpler pattern than the regular Non-Pro class.
Timed Event	Rules: Wran Regelbok 2024-25
NSBA Classes	 Requirement: NSBA membership in the USA is necessary for riders and owners to compete. Rules: NSBA rulebook More information – <u>www.nsba.se</u> Awards: 55% of the class fee will be refunded as prize money to the account provided by the participant/horse owner, after the show. 3 ribbons will be awarded in all NSBA classes. Only NSBA-S members compete for NSBA-S Year End Awards ranking. Only NSBA USA members compete for NSBA USA's ranking.
NSBA Young Horse Cup	 Eligibility: Horses aged 2 – 3. Requirement: NSBA-S membership needed for owners and participants. Horses starting in the Young Horse Cup is <u>forbidden</u> to be ridden under the show, and at the show grounds.
AQHA	 Rules: AQHA Rulebook Requirements: AQHA membership for riders and owners is required to compete in AQHA classes, together with an Affiliate membership. See <u>www.nqha.no</u> for an NQHA membership. The horse is registered in AQHA. Awards: Ribbons for 1st-6th place, sponsored by NQHA. Memberships should already be arranged upon arrival at the competition venue, but they can also be arranged on-site. Payments can then be made from your credit card directly to AQHA. You must be a member of NQHA or other affiliate membership to compete in a AQHA class, for example SQHA. Vaccination & Horse Pass	By arrival go to the show office and show the horse pass with vaccination card, <u>before</u> entering the stalls
	All horses must have current vaccination against A2 Virus and is updated with the required vaccination. Last vaccination needs to be done no later than <u>10 days</u> before show.
Free Riding	The show arena will be available for free riding during most breaks as well as before and after the show unless otherwise stated. Refer to specific information in the arena regarding any limitations on this.
	Riders need to leave the arena when the tractor comes to drag.
Show Office	Opens no later than 19:00 on Wednesday, June 26th.
	Other times will be posted on-site and on social media.
	Only entries made on the official entry form are allowed. No text messages, Facebook, or chat messages are accepted. The secretariat is usually open until 1 hour after the last class of the day.
Late Enteries	Already registered horses can add classes up to 1 hour before the class. If start lists have been issued, late entries will start first.
	The aim is to publish start lists 2 hours before the start; for the first class of the day, lists will be published the night before.
	Late entry for the first class of the day should be made the day before.
	Entries must be made on the official entry form; no entries made on Facebook, Messenger, or SMS will be accepted!

Starting number	The correct number must be visible when the horse is ridden or longed at the competition venue. If a starting number not provided by the show office is used, the used starting number must be at least as large as the ones provided.
	starting numbers provided by the show office must be returned to the secretariat. Any starting number not returned will be charged 100 NOK.
Show Arena & Warm Up Pen	- No horses/riders/trainers/audience standing in entrance/exit of the Show Arena and Warm-Up pen.
	Think about safety!
	No hay allowed in the Show Arena or Warm-Up pen!
Ethical rules	The horse must be at least three years old to be ridden within the competition area.
	A mare that has reached 7 months of pregnancy and/or has a foal at her side may not be ridden within the competition area.
	Inhumane treatment of horses within the competition area will result in disqualification from the competition.
	All warm-up sessions will be monitored, and excessive use of spurs, bits, whips, or similar will result in a warning, followed by disqualification.
	All fees paid will be forfeited and will not be refunded in cases of disqualification.
	The competition management recommends helmets for youth riders when riding within the competition area.
	Doping tests may occur during the competition
Horse Welfare	Regarding the welfare and well-being of the horses, the show management recommends that you choose your classes carefully, taking into account not to over-compete your horse. The show management will contact you and advise if we see it necessary.
	Make sure your horse always has water. The stalls are monitored frequently throughout the day.
Food	At the competition venue, there is a restaurant (Big Dream Steakhouse) attached to the indoor arena where you can have lunch and dinner. Inside the indoor arena, there is also a kiosk where you can buy drinks, hot dogs, etc.
